WHEREAS, South Carolina's anglers and hunters recognize the tremendous value of our game fish and animals and support the conservation efforts, including education, licensing, and enforcement, of the Department of Natural Resources (DNR); and

WHEREAS, hunting and fishing promote the health of our fish and wildlife by helping sustain healthy populations.

NOW, THEREFORE, I, Nikki R. Haley, Governor of the great State of South Carolina, do hereby proclaim September 26, 2015, as

throughout the state and encourage all South Carolinians to recognize our sportsmen and women and the many social, cultural, economic, and ecological benefits of our hunting and fishing traditions.
