The Congressional Sportsmen's Foundation (CSF) works with Congress, governors, and state legislatures to protect and advance hunting, angling, recreational shooting and trapping. Known as the "Voice of America's Sportsmen and Women", CSF interacts with nearly 300 members of the Congressional Sportsmen's Caucus (CSC), 2,000 state legislators under the National Assembly of Sportsmen's Caucuses (NASC) and 32 members from the Governors Sportsmen's Caucus (GSC) giving CSF a unique presence in the halls of government.
