Enhancement (SHARE) Act**



- Polar Bear Conservation and Fairness Act (H.R. 1818)
- Permanent Electronic Duck Stamp Act (H.R. 1206)
- Access to Water Resources Development Projects Act (H.R. 2046)
- Wildlife and Hunting Heritage Conservation Council Advisory Committee (H.R. 2799)
- Recreational Fishing and Hunting Heritage and Opportunities Act (H.R. 1825)
